Who can apply?

Any high school senior or first year college student who exhibits an animal at the Sauk County Fair in the current application year.

Scholarship:

One \$500 scholarship will be awarded based on essay and qualifications of the applicant. The scholarship will be awarded at the Meat Animal Sale during the Sauk County Fair. Recipients will receive scholarship funds after completion of one full-time college semester. A transcript and copy of 2nd semester full-time schedule should be submitted to initiate payment.

Essay:

Tell about your involvement in 4H and/or FFA and how it has had a positive impact in your life. List your involvement in school activities and your community and tell what you have learned from it. Explain your educational and future goals and how your experiences in 4H and/or FFA will help you achieve your goals.

Reference:

Please include one letter of reference from an individual that has worked with you in 4H, FFA or in your academics. The letter should include their address and phone number.
