

Sauk County Meat Animal Sale

Scholarship Application

ELIGIBILITY: Any graduating high school senior or first year college student eligible to exhibit at the current Sauk County Fair. Applicant must be or have been an exhibitor of a meat animal project at the Sauk Co Fair. Applicant must be currently enrolled in 4-H or FFA. Applicants may only receive this scholarship one time.

AWARD: A total of \$2000 scholarship money is available and will be awarded in two \$1000 scholarships as determined by the Meat Animal Sale Committee based on the number of applicants and their qualifications. The scholarship(s) will be awarded at the Meat Animal Sale during the Sauk County Fair. Scholarship recipients will receive scholarship money after completion of the following Fall full-time student semester, transcript submitted and copy of the Spring semester full-time student schedule. Scholarship money needs to be requested within one year of award date.

Applications are due by May 17.
