Information & Rules & Requirements:

- Domesticated Exotic Animals include the following: Goats, Llamas, Alpacas, Miniature horses, donkeys, mules, sheep, pigs and any other animal with prior approval.
- Only one animal per lot with grand total of animals by exhibitor limited to 10 in the department.
- No mature adult male species. Only fixed/alterd adult male animals will be allowed.
- No Stallions or mature adult male species of any kind including goats, llamas, alpacas, miniature horses, donkeys or mules Allowed. Only fixed adult male animals will be allowed
- Only one animal per class per exhibitor. (Exception is Doe/Kid Class and Dam/Cria Class)
- Goats need official ID may be scrapies Tag, USDA 840 button, or breed association tattoo (with paperwork, as long as it is unique to that animal) Goats exposed to scrapies will not be allowed to show.
- Llamas and Alpacas from within Wisconsin do not have official Id requirements. Llamas, alpacas from outside Wisconsin must have a certificate of veterinary inspection and official animal health records
- All equine (horses, donkeys, mules & hinnies) need proof of Coggins within last 12 months and health records
- Premise ID required on online entry forms
- to show in wether class, the goat must be banded or surgically wethered (no crimping). Must visually be a wether.
- Decorations: We encourage use of fair theme for the Exotic Animal Barn
- Department/Project members are encouraged to put up decorations prior to the fair. Check with the superintendent for more information. Decorations may not be removed until 4pm Sunday of fair.
- Exhibitors need to pay a fee for each animal brought to fair, per animal not pen. No pens are private, and exhibitors should expect to possibly share a pen, families and farms are grouped together first.
- Award will be given for cleanest pen and best animal care for the week.
- You **MUST** sign up for barn duty daily with the Superintendent
- Exhibitors must attend at least 2 exotic animal department/project meetings in the current exhibit year to be eligible to show at the fair.
- Only exotic exhibitors or other family members may be in ring at judging time.
- **All Exhibitors need to check in with the superintendent daily, morning & night, when animals are at the fair.**
- **Goats being shown in Exotics should be registered using the SCF Exotics Animal choice**

Costume Class Rules, Requirements and Criteria

- All Animals must sign up during registration to receive premiums.
- Exhibitors may only show **ONE** animal species
- All animal exhibitors are welcome to show **ONE** of the animals they have at the fair.
 - Exotics, Dairy, Beef, Sheep, Goats, Horse, Swine, Poultry, Rabbit
- All animals participating in the costume class must be on a halter/lead

Main Judging Points for the Costume Class:

1. Coverage
 - a. The costume covers over 60% of the animal
 - b. The costume covers over 60% of the exhibitor
2. Acceptance of Costume
 - a. The animal accepts the costume - No stomping, No shaking or balking
 - b. The animal walks/moves normally with the costume - No sidestepping, hopping
3. Unified theme of Costumes
 - a. The exhibitor and animal are in costume.
 - b. The costumes create a unified theme.
 - c. The theme is easily identifiable.
4. **Construction of Costume-New, handmade, thrifted, customized and originally Exhibitor created costumes only!**
 - a. Fits animal well – not falling off the animal
 - b. The costume must be safe for the exhibitor and the animal to wear and move around.
 - c. Allows the animal and exhibitor to maintain visual acuity.
