- Arrangements judged on flower conditions, color and line and design
- All flowers must be grown by exhibitor unless noted
- No exhibitor may make more than one entry in any lot/prize number

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**CLASS 2 – HOUSE PLANTS & INDOOR GARDENING**

- All plants must be grown indoors, under ordinary house conditions
- Containers may not exceed 8" in diameter
- All entries must have an attached card with the following information: Plant Name, Date Started, Propagation Method

3	Landscape plans include pictures of before and after and show improvements made.
4	Any other home grounds exhibit or poster (14" x 22")
