Rules & Requirements:

- All photos must be ready to be hung, with a hanger, of some sort.

Preparation of Exhibits and Rules

Read & Follow the Rules Remember:

1. No exhibitor may make more than one entry in any prize/lot number
2. No exhibitor may enter both open and junior class.
3. All pictures and slides must be made during the 12 months since the start of the last fair.
4. Exhibits with images of the exhibitor in the picture will be disqualified and removed, unless entered into the "Picture of self-class"
5. Each photo may be entered only once. Duplicate entries will be disqualified and removed.
6. Judging: photographs will be judged on the basis of technical quality, composition, and storytelling ability.

Choose Photos and prepare

7. Use sturdy cardboard, tag board or foam core, cut to or 14" x 11" for 4 or fewer pictures, and 14" x 22" for 5 or more pictures as stated.
8. Use double-stick tape or rubber cement to mount pictures. No photo corners.
 - a. **NOTE:** it is suggested that pictures be mounted with double stick tape.
9. Each picture should not be any larger than 4" x 6" except if the directions are marked differently.
10. Cropping is accepted and encouraged.
11. Recommendation: **Don't use date stamped photos**
12. Exhibits of **5 or more pictures** must be mounted on sturdy cardboard, tagboard, or foam core that is 14" x 22"
13. Exhibits of **4 or fewer pictures** must be mounted on sturdy cardboard, tagboard, or foam core that is 14" x 11"
14. All single enlargements should be mounted or matted, on any size background material, or placed in a frame. Captions on pictures are encouraged for each picture, **Write title as simple as possible.**

Before you bring your photos to the fair:

15. **Display Camera Used,** exhibit must **display on the lower right-hand corner side** of the front of the exhibit the type of camera, tablet, phone used. (ie: 35mm, Samsung galaxy6, ipad, etc.) the make, (ie: Olympus, Canon) and the model (ie: Easyshare, ZD86, Rebel, etc)
16. **Attach entry tag on the upper left-hand front corner** of the exhibit.
17. **Ready to Hang: Make sure your exhibit is ready to hang. With hanger, photo clips, string etc.**
18. Place slide exhibits in reusable (metal or string) envelope. Do not mount. Slides will be viewed and judged with a slide projector. Initial and number each individual slide.

All entries not complying with rules will receive a pink ribbon.

The picture will be disqualified and removed for rules 13 & 14.

Ideas for photos: vacation or special event, sports or action, people involved in youth groups, people, candid not posed people, pictures of silhouettes, reflections, or shadows, buildings, barns, tell a story, flowers, agricultural scenes, sunrise/sunset, animals.

12	Four flash portraits showing fill - in flash and/or bounce flash. - Black & White or Sepia
13	Four pictures taken with existing light indoors. - Black & White or Sepia
14	Four pictures showing creative use of lens filter(s). - Black & White or Sepia

15	Four Stop Action photos. - Black & White or Sepia
16	Four pictures showing special effects or double exposure techniques - Black & White or Sepia
17	Four close-up or macro photographs - Black & White or Sepia
18	Four close-up or macro photographs - Black & White or Sepia

Enlargements Black & White or Sepia

19	One 8"x10" enlargement of Sauk County tourism - Black & White or Sepia
20	One 8" x 10" enlargement of youth group activity - Black & White or Sepia
21	One 8" x 10" enlargement of a posed picture - Black & White or Sepia
22	One 8" x 10" enlargement of a landscape - Black & White or Sepia
23	One "5x7" enlargement of any subject - Black & White or Sepia

23	Four pictures – Creative collage (photos only. 4-8 images, may vary in size and shape
24	Instagram format mounted attractively (six pictures)

25	One 8"x10" enlargement of Sauk County tourism - Color
26	One 8" x 10" enlargement of youth group activity - Color
27	Any subject (5"x7") –Color
28	Same theme (one 5"x7" and two smaller pictures)- Color
29	Picture of self, taken with or without timer (if timer was used write "timer" on lower right corner) (5"x7") –Color
30	Any subject (8"x10") –Color
31	Posed portrait (8"x10") – Color
32	Best picture, any subject (8"x10")
33	Landscape (manmade allowed) (8"x10")
34	Still life (three-to-five inanimate, nonliving objects arranged by photographer) (5"x7")

Photo Editing All Ages & Levels

35	Photo editing: two prints no larger than 4" x 6", any subject one before (original print) and one after (edited print)
36	One video produced by exhibitor on any topic. Max 2 min. State production techniques. Must be flash drive
37	Grades 9+, Career Portfolio of exhibitor's photo career. 12 photos of any size, subject. In 3 ring binder, page protectors, one photo per page. Include year photo taken.
