Rules and Requirements: MARKET SHOW & BREED SHOW

- Exhibitors should contact the superintendent or fair office to get Sauk County Fair Ear tags for their animals. Identification sheets must be uploaded into the registration entry system by Close of Registration
- Each exhibitor is allowed to show two market hogs (barrows, gilts, or one of each)
- Each exhibitor is allowed to sell only one animal, except for exceptions listed in Live Market Animal Sale.
- For Swine Identification-All hogs will be identified by completing the Swine Identification sheet with ear notches, an ear tag, distinctive color patterns and the sex.
- Animals may be identified by a Wisconsin State Fair Tag, used to identify their animal/per the rules of WI. State Fair
- A required market ID form must be completed for each animal– check fair website or watch your club newsletters for more details. All hogs must be identified by ear notch and ear tag. The ear notching should have been done shortly after the animal was born. Vo-Ag and/or leaders are not responsible for ear notching your animal. Each youth is allowed to identify six market hogs.
- Swine from within Wisconsin need a Wisconsin intrastate certificate of veterinary inspection (CVI or health certificate): Stating that the entire herd of origin was inspected on the farm within 30 days before the show and showed no signs of disease.
- Swine from outside of Wisconsin, see DATCP rules in back of fair book.
- **All swine must have a PRRS (Porcine Reproductive and Respiratory Syndrome) and SECD (Swine Enteric Coronavirus Disease) test of the herd of origin within 90 days of the exhibition.**
- Animal must be born after January 1 of the exhibit year.
- To be eligible for the Live Market Animal Sale swine must be a minimum of 235lbs and no more than 285lbs maximum. Your hog may weigh over 285 lbs; however, it will only sell at that maximum 285lbs.

NOTE: Animals weighing over the maximum weight (285lbs for swine) will still be eligible for the sale but the buyer of the animal will only pay up to maximum weight.

If you are entering 2 barrows or gilts - please list twice on your online entry form

Breed Specific

- All purebreds must have registration paperwork, if not they will be marked as a crossbred.
- Classes will be split up by breed and weight. Barrows and gilts will be shown together.
- If there are less than five hogs per breed they will be put into an Any Other Breed Class.
- Championship drive will consist of each breed champion.
