CLASS 1 – YOUTH LEADERSHIP

1	A display designed to recruit members or to improve club/organization work
3	Scrapbook or poster of leadership experience.

2	A visual aid the exhibitor used to teach a specific topic.
4	Any other exhibit on youth leadership not listed.

CLASS 2 – SELF DETERMINED

8	Poster explaining the self-determined exhibit and work, 14" x 22" and ready to hang.
10	A booklet describing goals & work done in self-determined exhibit.

9	A display of articles made for your self-determined exhibit with a 3" x 5" card attached explaining the exhibit.
11	Any other display relating to the self-determined exhibit.

CLASS 1 - HEALTH

1	Poster relating to health, 14" x 22" and ready to hang
3	A fitness display
5	Exhibit on home safety hazards

2	Any display relating to health
4	Display on reducing stress

CLASS 2 – HISTORY & HERITAGE

6	Family tree properly recorded may include pictures.
8	Biography of an ancestor (may include pictures).
10	Exhibit or report about your family's settlement in an area (may include pictures).
12	Heritage box with old family possessions (identify the possessions and the generations) Exhibitor must set up and arrange items in box, basket or similar enclosure before it is judged.
14	Yesteryear to today pictures and explanations of somebody or something related to family history.
16	Written account of an interview with an older resident (s) of the community (may include pictures)
18	An exhibit or early farming or industry in your community which shows methods used for production in the past.
20	Written report of a current or potential community landmark (may include pictures)

7	Written account of an interview of a family member (may include pictures).
9	Geographic map(s) and narrative tracing your family ancestor(s) migration from where they originated to present (use an adequate explanation and be creative)..
11	Historical research on the family farm or family home (may include pictures).
13	A written report and collection of genealogical correspondence used in searching for your family roots.
15	A picture history (past and present) or written report about historical developments of the community in which you live.
17	An exhibit about early settlers or Native Americans in your area.
19	An exhibit of an old art or craft (attach explanation of process and materials used). (may include pictures)
21	Any other exhibit of historical significance and explanation (may include pictures)
