**Rules & Requirements:**

Exhibits previously exhibited at the Sauk County Fair are NOT eligible for competition.

- Face to Face Judging, all ages are combined.
- The judge will make comments and give placing according to appropriate work for the exhibitors age.
- No exhibitor may make more than one entry in any prize/lot number. **(As**  
**an example-if you are bringing a watercolor -scenic painting in department 18, class 1, lot 6-etc, you may only enter that department, class and lot with ONE watercolor-scenic item. You cannot enter two of department 18, class 1, lot 6-etc. You may enter other lots, but only one lot in each class and department.**
- Performance arts Performance arts entries are completed earlier in spring in a separate competition for registered exhibitors only.
- Only enter these exhibits if you participated in this competition.
- If you participated in this competition held prior to the fair, you must enter online during the fair registration for premiums to be paid.
